Printing is a modern way of applying patterns to fabric. Printing can be done using special inks or dyes, as well as electronics and computer technology.

Richelieu is a technique in which threads are passed through the fabric in a plane parallel to the surface of the material, creating a volumetric effect. Beading is a type of embroidery in which beaded beads are attached to the fabric, creating various patterns and details.
