"Using collaborative technology, you can do grammar tasks, homework check tasks, work on a reading text, work together on a project, develop spelling skills, work on vocabulary" In my practice, the text I often use this technology while studying. Reading and translating a large text, answering questions, searching for the necessary information can sometimes be boring for students. Not all students may be satisfied with participation in this work. Collaborative technology can help solve these problems. The problem of encouraging students' independent educational activities is very important. Collaborative work is a great incentive for learning, communication, because in this case you always rely on the help of your friends. Another modern method is the project method. The project form of work is one of the most relevant technologies that allows students to apply the knowledge they have gathered on the subject. Students expand their thinking and language skills. They work with literature, dictionaries and computers. Working on a project is a creative process. The student solves the problem independently or under the guidance of the teacher, which

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requires not only knowledge of the language, but also a large amount of knowledge, creative, communicative and intellectual skills.
