



## THE ROLE OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY IN TEACHING A FOREIGN LANGUAGE

With their help, you can clarify your homework, share links to educational resources, and monitor the level of completion of certain tasks outside the educational institution. The use of the above resources creates a special modern system of education for students of the new generation and becomes an integral part of their lives. It is important for a teacher to try to arouse in students a desire to learn and gain knowledge. The skill of a teacher lies in the ability to make the content of a subject rich, deep and attractive under any conditions and circumstances, which in turn strengthens and develops the cognitive activity of children in the learning process.
