93% of households now have internet access (2024)

Mobile penetration has surpassed 80% [1]

Just a decade ago, such numbers were unimaginable. Today, smartphones, fast internet, and rising digital literacy have unlocked entire sectors of online services. Markets traditionally dominated by cash transactions and informal networks are increasingly shifting into digital ecosystems.





This widening digital access is not merely technological progress — it is reshaping consumer behavior, accelerating economic participation, and creating opportunities for thousands of new entrepreneurs.

IT Park Uzbekistan: The Engine of Modern Innovation

At the heart of this transformation lies IT Park Uzbekistan — the country’s most influential digital development hub. In 2019, it hosted only a few resident companies.

Today, it has over 2,800 firms, including hundreds of foreign-owned companies. [2]

IT Park’s success is driven by a powerful incentives package: corporate tax exemptions, customs privileges, simplified export procedures. [3]

Beyond fiscal benefits, IT Park has built a full ecosystem: incubators, co-working spaces, training programs, startup accelerators, and venture fund networks. For young founders, this means the opportunity to develop ideas locally — with the ambition and infrastructure to scale globally.

A defining strength of Uzbek startups is their approach: they solve real, local problems — but design their solutions for global scalability.

Fintech

Digital payment platforms streamline transactions, support small businesses, and reduce reliance on inefficient banking systems.

Logistics & E-commerce

Tech-driven delivery platforms transform supply chains across Uzbekistan’s vast geography, enabling faster, more reliable distribution.

Edtech

Online learning platforms expand educational access, especially in rural regions, filling long-standing gaps in tutoring, test preparation, and digital literacy.

Agritech

Apps modernize agriculture by connecting farmers to markets, optimizing supply chains, and analyzing crop predictions.

These innovations are grounded in Uzbekistan’s realities — but applicable to other emerging markets across Central Asia, South Asia, and beyond.

Funding, Global Recognition & the Rise of National Champions

For years, startup growth was hindered by limited access to capital. That barrier is now shifting dramatically.

Startup investment surged from under US\$1 million to nearly US\$70 million in 2024–2025. [4]

Uzbekistan entered the Global Startup Ecosystem Index (2025) global Top 100 for the first time. [5]





One of the most symbolic milestones is the emergence of Uzbekistan’s first unicorn, Uzum, valued at over US\$1 billion. [6]

This milestone demonstrates that large-scale, high-value companies can emerge from Uzbekistan — and paves the way for new founders to aim higher.

Growing interest from foreign investors, regional venture funds, and international accelerators signals that Uzbekistan is becoming a strategic innovation hub in Central Asia.

Perhaps the most transformative element is the mindset shift among Uzbekistan’s youth.

With access to global knowledge networks, online education, coding bootcamps, and entrepreneurial communities, young innovators are adopting problem-solving practices aligned with global startup standards.
