However, if they practice using these words in context repeatedly, they will become natural over time. To achieve natural-sounding speech, learners should use more idiomatic language and expressions. For example, instead of saying something is "easy," they can say "a piece of cake." If someone feels sick, they could say "under the weather" rather than simply "feeling sick." Idioms make speech sound more natural.

Idioms are common in everyday speech but are rarely the subject of psychological research. They appear in every language. For instance, Weinreich (1969) notes that a Russian phraseological dictionary lists more than 25,000 entries. In general, linguists have dealt with idiomaticity as a semi-productive pattern within generative grammar (e.g., Katz & Postal, 1964; Weinreich, 1969). This study approaches idioms from the perspective of

information processing rather than linguistic analysis and is concerned with comprehension rather than production. The most important way to enhance speaking skills is to practice public speaking.
