However, the peer review processes and standards of conventional publishing have not succeeded in sifting through the overwhelming amount of unfiltered information online (Afrah Adil Mahmood, 2023). In my point of view, learners especially students should be taught by their teachers or instructors how to find a trustworthy and safe information from different websites. Because it can be challenging for individuals who are not sufficiently knowledgeable in the language they are learning to distinguish between genuine information and misinformation. The research conducted by Moh. Choirul Huda highlights the flexibility that online resources provide regarding time and location. Learners may value the ability to study at their convenience, regardless of place, but they might also perceive that online learning lacks adequate structure and opportunities for direct interaction with instructors and peers (Moh. Choirul Huda, 2023). I would contend that it can be difficult for some students to study while constantly moving from one location to another, as this consumes significant time and energy that could otherwise be dedicated to acquiring new knowledge. So studying from destination with the help of digital tools and accesss to internet can give opportunity to spend more time for learning. Therefore, studying from various locations using digital tools and internet access allows learners to dedicate more time to their studies. A lack of digital technologies and limited internet access can also serve as a barrier. A 2019 study conducted by the British Council (Tinsley, 2019) revealed that the most widely used online resources for English language learning include: Websites (41%), Apps (30%), Video platforms (20%), Online courses (9%), and Other resources (10%). The study also indicated that students who utilized a diverse range of online resources were more likely to advance in their English language learning compared to those who relied on a single type of resource. (Moh. Choirul Huda 2023). From my perspective, utilizing a variety of online resources can be more effective than relying on a single type. By incorporating diverse formats such as videos, applications, online courses, and websites, learners can enhance different aspects of their language skills. Each resource type offers unique benefits: videos can improve listening and comprehension, apps provide interactive practice, online courses often deliver structured
