5. Selfie with teacher once! Have a conversation and take a selfie with one of your students. This opportunity will be unexpected and very interesting for the students. Therefore, it contributes to establishing a sincere relationship between the teacher and the students.

It is possible to expand this list according to the age and desires of the students!
