#### REFLECTION

We can usually use reflexive methods at the beginning of the lesson or at the end of the lesson. Because when we use reflexive methods at the end of a new topic, the content of the new topic will be reflected in the students' memory. We will consider one of such reflexive methods below;

ACTIVATOR 3-2-1 method is one such reflexive method.

ACTIVATOR 3-2-1 method

Regulation: 3-5 minutes;

A large paper or presentation with an assignment.

The process of using this method: This method belongs to the group of reflexive methods and can usually be used at the end or at the beginning of lessons.

The task in the Activator 3-2-1 method is mainly based on the following questions.

1. I remember\_3

2. it was important \_2

3. I use \_1

\*I remember\_3. in this part, the participants are asked to write 3 pieces of information that they remembered during the lesson;

\*It became important\_2 . Here they should write down 2 pieces of information that were important to them during the lesson;

\*I use\_1. In this part, students are asked to write down what conclusion or specific idea, situation, or episode they have learned from the lesson and which they will "definitely use" in practice.

will have to perform this method individually in their notebooks . Information in the lesson through the activator 3-2-1 method . Participants will have to perform this method individually in their notebooks . Through the Activator 3-2-1 method, the information in the lesson is repeated, strengthened, and in most cases, the participants will be able to fill in their gaps with the help of the analyzes of other participants and get their shortcomings;

This method gives students the following advantages:

Helps the participants to remember the lesson, to repeat and consolidate it in memory ;

+ They have developed the ability to analyze in detail;

+The experience of being able to connect theoretical information with practical information is formed;

+ The oral and written speech of the participants develops;

+ The ability to synthesize information appears.

It offers several advantages to teachers:

+Through this method, it is possible to repeat the topic in an interesting and easy way and to strengthen the knowledge of the students on this topic;

Analyzing the information that the participants repeated a lot and that attracted their attention, that remained in their memory, and thus studying their areas of interest;

To find out the information that the students did not mention in the lesson, and the gaps in the lesson;

+ Determining the capabilities of the participants to analyze the data;

It helps to make the lesson more interesting, useful and purposeful, with the effective use of this information to study specific achievements and shortcomings of the lesson and to organize the process of the next lesson.
