HOW TO TEACH PAIR WORDS IN SCHOOLS?

Abstract. In this article, we will see how and which methods should be used to teach children for pair words. Pair words are considered as the words formed by joining two words together. Pair words exist in most languages and in some way they contribute to the richness of that language.

Key words: Pair words, methods, language, children, vocabulary, parallel words, relation, hyponomy, antonymy, synonymy, paronomy, semantic, syntagmatic relations.

It is obvious the notion pair words appeared in the middle English where paire meant "two things that match or go together," from early French paire (same meaning), from Latin paria "equal things," from par "equal" — related to compare, par, peer [wikipedia.org].

Pair words are words which are formed on the basis of the equal connection of two parts that do not have a lexical meaning and expresses such meaning as generalization [A.Hojiyev 2002;7]

Pair words also called as word pairs, they are two words that are frequently used together or have close relationships with each other are known as word pairs. Just like all the other languages, English also has many word pairs. For instance, pen-paper, soup-water, fork-knife, brother-sister. Word pairs are a set of two words that are commonly used together and have a close relation. For example, lock – key [crestolimpiads.com].

Pair words also used as parallel pair words where most pair words in the Bible occur in parallel in constructions, with the A-words in the first parallel line and the B-word in the second parallel line. Watson and most other biblical scholars argued that one of the important criteria for identifying pair words are that the two words occur in parallel lines, such as like snow in summer and like rain at harvest [J.Duke2003; 34-35].

Pair words belong to the second method of formation of new lexical units (word builder). In the formation of pairs of words, the syntagmatic relationship of the parts are carried out with the helps of equal communication. The feature "serves to distinguish them from compound words" characterized by the syntagmatic relationship of their parts. A number of lexical-content (lexical-semantic) relationships between pairs of words also apply. They include: 1) Hyponomic relationship, (hand-foot, melon-watermelon, apple-

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apricot and etc.). 2) Relation of synonymy (strength-power, desire -lust and etc.) 3) Relation of antonymy (young-old, boy-girl, white-black, good- bad and etc.) 4) Relationship of partnomy (moon-day, mountain-stone and etc). It is obvious that pair words are made up of two words in an order that is logically consistent with each other. Pair words play essential role in linguistics. Because they are mostly joined by the conjuction "and". For example, Teacher and student.

Some people call these Binomials, binomial phrases

The present paper aims at explaining the distribution pair of words in the English language based on different types of similarities they may have. Every word in every language has three different aspects, representation and meaning or semantics. Some words in the English language may be similar in one or several aspects. For instance, two words may have similar meaning but different spelling.

Pairs words always consist of two (sometimes three) similar words. They are related words. For example;

Tea and biscuits
Read and write
Summer and winter
Day and night
Pots and pans
Sweet and sour

Fish and chips

We can learn pair words with different methods:

1.Method: This method is one of the most interesting methods in which children have to find pairs of words in the table;

In this method, children's concentration as well as finding speed increases and matching ability increases by finding their pairs


• 3.Method is test. In this method type we will have multiple question type and each question will have 3options we need to find the correct option.

4.Fish skeleton. It will have words on 1 side and we have to write them in pairs.




For instance; pepper and salt


